Rye Harbour Nature Reserve is one of the largest and most important wildlife sites in England, set in an exceptional coastal and wetland landscape and home to 4,500 varieties of plants and animals, including more than 300 considered nationally rare or endangered.

Sussex Wildlife Trust, who manage the Reserve in partnership with the Friends of Rye Harbour Nature Reserve and other partners, have identified the need for a purpose-built visitor centre to replace Lime Kiln Cottage which is cold and damp.

Plans and a public fundraising campaign are well advanced for the new Discovery Centre, but we need your help to raise the remaining one-third of the funds required.
